Regulation eIDAS

Why Regulation eIDAS?



Regulation (EU) 910/2014 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on electronic identification and trust services for electronic transactions in the internal market and repealing Directive 1999/93/EC (eIDAS regulation)

Problems:


- <u>Lack of legal certainty</u> because of different national transpositions of Directive on electronic signature (1999/93/ES).
- Lack of <u>interoperability</u> of systems.
- Different use of technical standards.
- No legal framework for mutual cross-border recognition of e-identifications and trust services.

Solution:

• Ensuring <u>trust</u> in electronic transactions in <u>internal market</u> in the area of electronic identification and trust services → <u>eIDAS regulation</u>

Regulation eIDAS – Building blocks





eIDAS - Trust Services



Trust service means an electronic service normally provided for remuneration which consists of:

- a) the creation, verification, and validation of electronic signatures, electronic seals or electronic time stamps, electronic registered delivery services and certificates related to those services, or
- b) the creation, verification and validation of certificates for website authentication; or
- c) the preservation of electronic signatures, seals or certificates related to those services;

Qualified trust service:


- 1. Issuing qualified certificates for electronic signatures
- **2. Validation** of qualified electronic signatures
- **3. Preservation** of qualified electronic signatures
- 4. Issuing qualified certificates for electronic seals
- **5. Validation** of qualified electronic seals
- **6. Preservation** of qualified electronic seals
- 7. Issuing qualified certificates for web site authentication
- 8. Issuing qualified time stamps
- Qualified electronic registered delivery




Trust Services – Services in the Internal Market





Qualified Trust Service Providers - Slovenia






